MEMBERSHIP:

Adult female members of St. Andrews Bay Yacht Club are eligible for membership and are encouraged to join this energetic and active group. Dues of members are \$50.00 per year due January 1.

PURPOSE:

The ladies have a varied calendar of social events and special functions monthly. They are involved in many aspects of the Club refurbishment. MEETINGS:

RULES:

All reservations made for luncheons that are not kept must be paid for unless canceled through the vice president by the Tuesday night preceding the luncheon.

Executive board meetings will be held on Thursday following luncheon dates.

The secretary shall solicit reservations and provide a list for both bridge and lunch to the vice president by Tuesday night prior to the luncheon, so that she may notify the club management of the number of reservations on Wednesday morning. Members, if you are not contacted, please call the vice president. A list of new members will be given to the membership chair who will notify the secretary monthly.

When desired, arrangements for pre-meeting bridge play may be made. Bridge begins promptly at 10:00am. Bridge tables will be set up for those who confirmed their reservations with the secretary.

Only members in good standing may attend the annual party. Members are allowed one (1) guest only. Guest is defined as husband, date, friend or child. A child and their spouse are considered as two (2) guests.
