

St Andrews Bay Yacht Club, member Boat Usage Agreement - Proficiency

PROCEDURE: Demonstration of sailing proficiency by members desiring to use StABYC boats.

Members wishing to take advantage of Club boats, made available for use outside a structured StABYC class, should follow the following procedure. The Office can provide the paperwork to be completed.

1. Complete the StABYC Participant Waiver/Release and Boat usage Agreement. (To be retained by the Club's Office).
2. Complete the Candidate's part of the Demonstration of Sailing Proficiency Sheet. This should include the desired vessels for which the member seeks approval.
3. As the Club has no waterfront staff, assessment is conducted by fellow Club members, who have experience with a particular dinghy class. This is not intended to be any kind of judgement or exam, rather a reassurance for the Club that the member is safe and responsible both for him/herself and to Club property and to provide advice.
4. The following boats are maintained for Club member use: (#s on the Starboard bow)
